## Policy Reminders

**TUITION** is divided into nine equal **MOO-lah** payments. The payment remains the same regardless of absences, holidays, weather cancellations, and/or recital dates. Tuition is **due on the 1<sup>st</sup>** of each month and **late after the 10<sup>th</sup>** of the month regardless of weekends, cancellations, or holidays. **After the 10<sup>th</sup>** an additional **\$5.00 late fee** must be paid. **After the 20<sup>th</sup>** of the month, if the tuition and \$5.00 late fee has not been paid, the student will not be allowed to participate in class and will be counted absent. Your first payment is due by August 20th and your last payment is due April 1<sup>st</sup>. **We accept Cash, Check or Card. When paying with check, please put your child's first & last name on the memo line. This year we are also offering a monthly Autopay Option. Sign up at the office.**



**POTTY TIME** - Parents, please make sure your child uses the restroom before or after class, especially the 2, 3, & 4 year olds. These interruptions take away from your child's learning time. Please do not allow your child to change clothes in the lobby or restrooms. A dressing room is provided for this purpose. We also offer a family dressing room. We know that sometimes it seems inconvenient for dad's to help their little daughters change for dance because men are not allowed in the girl's dressing room. Now the dads can take their daughters in the family dressing room or Moms can take their sons in the family dressing room too.



**HAIR-** should always be pulled away from the face. Students should also be properly dressed for class.



**PARKING** - Please enter and exit through the correct driveways to allow traffic to flow more easily. Traffic is very busy at our location so please be extra cautious. Also, for those that need to travel to 258N or for those that need to head east, we have a drive way that goes around the building. **DO NOT DRIVE THROUGH THE GRASS FIELD!!!** If you use that driveway to exit, you can go to the stoplight for safety. Also, if you are trying to take a short cut to 258N you can exit behind the building turn left on Jefferson, left on "A" street and it will put you back on 258N. Remember to **ALWAYS** be cautious and alert for children in the parking lot. **ALSO, PLEASE DO NOT BLOCK EITHER OF OUR DRIVE WAYS.**



**FOOD-** I am not discouraging you from using the vending machines, however there is to be no food or drink in the dance room or dressing room. **Please keep all food near the cafeteria tables in the lobby.** Also, remember to throw away trash and if there is a problem with the vending machine you can see someone in the office but until we leave phase 2 our machines are off. \$1 water in office.

### COSTUME DEPOSIT

Costumes range from \$50-\$90 each. **A deposit of \$25.00 per class is due September 1<sup>st</sup>** and another deposit of \$25.00 per class is due **October 1<sup>st</sup>**. The remaining balance will be due in November. Any student withdrawing after costumes have been ordered will be responsible for paying the balance on his/her costume(s).

### POINTE AUDITIONS

If your child is in 6th-12th Grade and has taken lyrical for at least 3 years, they are eligible to try out for pointe. Auditions will take place during the Tuesday 8:15-9:00 class for the first three weeks.
